





- One turn penalty



Courses





Fixed Marks Courses

- Revamp of fixed marks courses to streamline, including the addition of the extra courses used predominantly for WW
- Removed a number of longer length courses that have not been used over the past 4 years
- Longer distance races to have special courses set via NTCs, with the course set based on the predicted wind conditions for the day
- Focus on variety of fixed marks courses to cover most wind directions, including reciprocal courses for Northerly-Southerly directions
- Ability to shorten courses at Tower
- Addition of the Boat start Windward Gate option for fixed marks racing as has often been used in the Saturday Winter Series.
- Course numbering revised. Now grouped in course length and then start direction
- Laid Marks Courses
 - No significant changes, however note changes to mark colours



As outlined in SYC 2016 -17 Keelboat Notices of Race, I agree that all crew:-

- meet the membership requirements stated in RRS Rule 46 and Rule 56 and are a financial SYC member or hold a compliant Day Pass Membership
- if required by SYC, will be signed on electronically for each race via an app when available
- have carried out the mandatory Man Overboard (MOB) exercise and reviewed the Emergency Flow Chart overleaf on the boat as entered, prior to the start of the racing season (and new crew are added as they start racing with the boat).

The names of all the crew members who have completed the MOB exercise and read through the Race Officers and Skippers Emergency Flow Chart overleaf shall be listed on this register prior to the start of the racing season. The register shall be updated as new crew join the boat and take part in the exercise. A copy of this register shall be retained on the boat and at SYC Boating office.

It shall be the responsibility of the person in charge of the boat to ensure that all crew on board for each race comply with the above rules. Boats found in breach of the above conditions may be disqualified from each race without a protest hearing. This changes RRS rule 63.1
