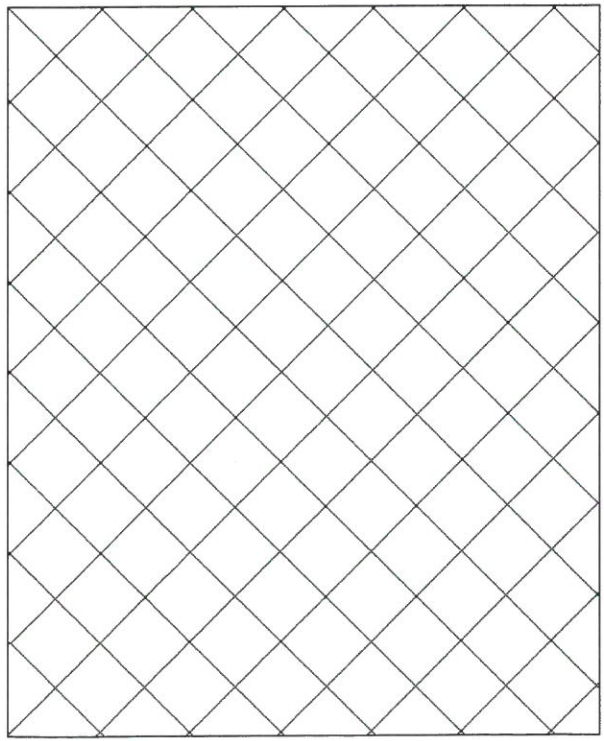

Facts Found:	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Billycart and Antares rounded SYC 5 and observed She's A Lady losing her mast.2. Both yachts liaised with SYC race tower offering assistance.3. Both yachts withdrew from racing and motored to She's A Lady to standby.4. Once She's a Lady was secured, she motored to the marina accompanied by both yachts who continued to maintain a supporting role.5. The time taken by both boats to render assistance was approximately 30 minutes.6. Both boats retired from the race.

Conclusions:	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Antares and Billycart gave all possible help to a vessel requiring assistance that may have been in danger. The duration of the assistance provided did not allow them to continue racing and finish within the cut off time.
