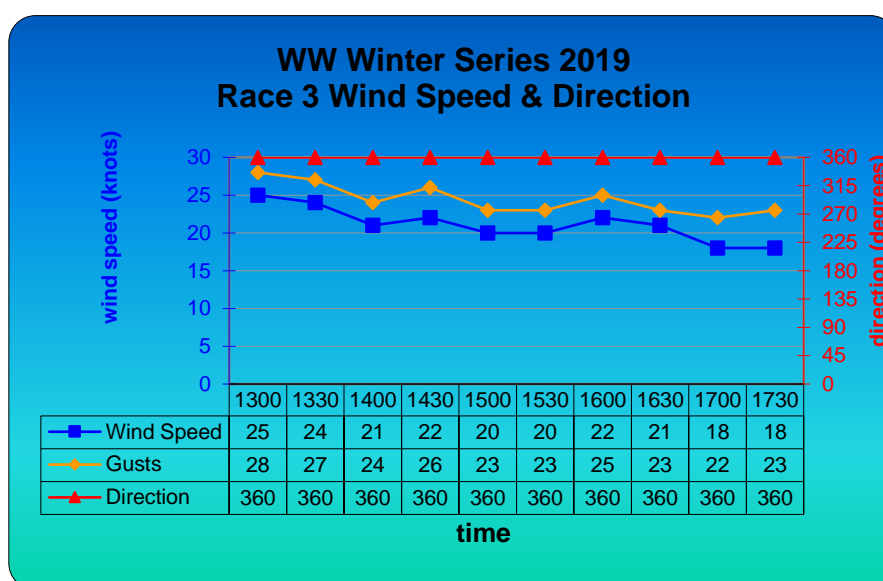


**Race Abandoned**  
**Wednesday Wonders Winter Series 2019 Race 3**  
**Plus**  
**Summer Series 2018-19 Trophy Results**  
 (18 Apr 2018)



Race 3 became the first casualty of the winter series when it was abandoned following a strong wind warning issued by the Bureau of Meteorology. The wind speed at Fawkner Beacon at 1330 was 24 knots with gusts around 27 knots. It did ease as the afternoon progressed and averaged 21 knots from the north with gusts over 25 knots.



After 2 completed races, ARABESQUE (Milton Green) and WICKED (Mike Welsh) are equal on points at the top of the aggregate. They are followed by LEBROK (Theo Korbel) and THE SECRETARY (George Shaw) also equal on points with INSX (Rob Sill) third.

*The Century Class will be a feature of the current winter series. The Class was introduced 7 years ago by Mark Windward. It is fully sponsored by Lee Windward, who remains anonymous, but is a Wednesday Wonder Sailor. So we thank him or her, for their generosity and support.*

*To be part of Century Class the age of the Skipper plus the age of your yacht needs to equal 100 years or more. It is expected to be a 6 race series held on the last Wednesday of every month.*

*If you qualify, and are not currently registered for the Century Class, see the Boating office ASAP so you can be included for the first Century Class race for the Winter Series. The first race is scheduled for the 24<sup>th</sup> April 2019.*

Fifty yachts competed in the 2018-19 summer aggregate. Seven yachts completed all the 20 races in the series and one of them, PIPPA (Jeffrey Woolhouse), won the aggregate by a margin of three points. The winner wasn't decided until the last race of the series when PIPPA moved from 10<sup>th</sup> place to the top. This is the second time in recent years that she has won the aggregate. Her previous win was the winter 2012 series.

However this wasn't decided until the last race of the summer series.

The Misty Blue Trophy is awarded to the boat having the lowest average time closest to her allocated start for the number of races scored in the Series. The trophy was won by ARCH DE TRIOMPHE with an average start time of 1.7 seconds. Her maximum time scored in the series was 2 seconds. THE SECRETARY was second with WICKED third.



The results for the summer series Century Class were very close. Count backs were required to determine the top three places. THE SECRETARY was third, BON VIVANT (Russell Keays) second with FUN & GAMES (Alan Edwards) the winner.

The Jaffa Trophy is awarded to the boat winning the Wednesday race closest to St Patrick's Day, being the race held on Wednesday 20 March 2019. A fleet of 40 yachts started the race which was delayed due to insufficient breeze. Despite the slow start the breeze increased and 39 yachts completed the 9.9 nautical mile course well within the time limit. Winning the race and the Jaffa Trophy by a margin of 3 minutes 43 seconds was ANDANTE 1 (Keith
