KEELBOATS AND POWERBOATS



Southerly Wind

On Shore


Code flag N will be displayed from both the Start Tower and the Ken King Centre.

The Commodore will visit each boat in the marina.

On Water

Code flag N will be displayed from both Endeavour IV and Boonoorong.

All boats to return to shore/marina immediately.



Participating boats are requested to be in their designated assembly areas by 13:40 and wait for instructions from Boonoorong operating on VHF channel 77.

OTB BOATS

OTB boats will commence at 13:50 with keelboats and powerboats at 14:00.

The official boat, Kingfisher II, will be anchored in the vicinity of SYC 4 mark. Participating boats will proceed from their designated assembly point, passing between the yellow inflatable buoy (not illustrated) and the Kingfisher II, giving three cheers to the Commodore who will be positioned at the stern of Kingfisher II.

The passing side of Kingfisher II will be determined on the day and communicated prior to the commencement of the Sail Past.

Keelboats and powerboats will be called on VHF channel 77 when ready to commence their sail past.

Boats can sail through in any order, forming a single line at a safe distance and giving clearance to the OTB boats.

We request that spinnakers are not to be used in winds above 20 knots.
