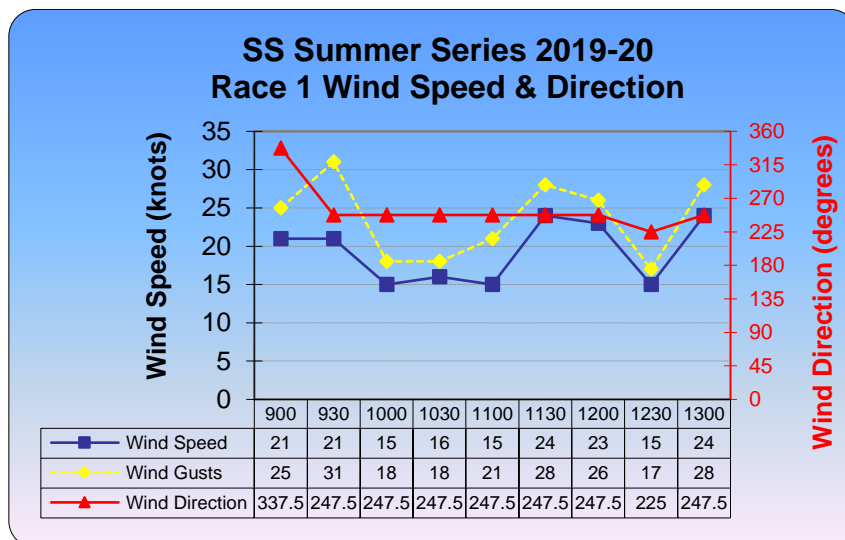


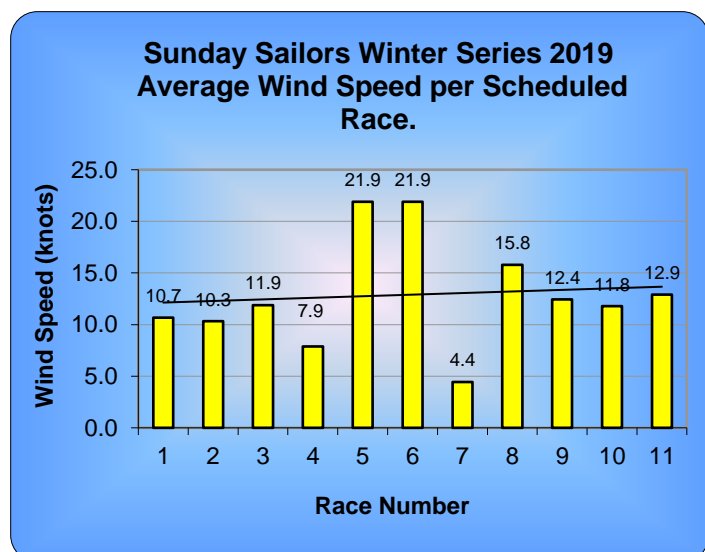
Not Quite to Plan Sunday Sailors Summer Series 2019-20 Race 1



The weather kept Sunday Sailors in the marina for the opening race of the summer series. Strong winds were forecast for Port Philip (downgraded from an earlier gale warning). The breeze at Fawkner Beacon averaged about 19 knots for the morning gusting to 31 knots at the scheduled start and to 28 knots about 1130.



The breeze had been kind to the winter series averaging about 13 knots for the 11 races. The highest average wind speed was 21.9 knots for both races 5 and 6 with the lowest average of 4.4 knots for race 4. Race 4 was one of 3 races to be shortened with only one (race 6) being abandoned.



There are two perpetual trophies to be awarded in this summer series:
 The Sunday Plate for the boat having the lowest combined score based on their placings in the Winter and Summer Sunday Series; and,
 The Noelle Coram trophy for the boat having the lowest combined score based on their placings in the Wednesday Wonders Summer Series and Sunday Sailors Summer Series.

The table shows the 26 yachts currently eligible for the Sunday Plate including their placing in the Winter Series. These include ALEGRIA, CASSANDRA of MELBOURNE, DELL ERA, PHOENIX and LA BELLE VIE who finished in the top six in the winter aggregate giving them a good start in the contest for the Sunday Plate.
