Facts Found:

- 1. White Pointer, Ragnar, Hot Chipps and Arch de Triomphe were all reaching in close company towards Mark 3 which was to be left to port.
- 2. At about 6 boat lengths from the mark, Arch de Triomphe established an overlap from clear astern, two or more boat lengths to windward of Hot Chipps.
- 3. When Ragnar entered the zone, both Arch de Triumph and Hot Chipps were overlapped inside her.
- 4. When Hot Chipps entered the Zone, she was clear astern of White Pointer by a small amount and Arch de Triomphe was still overlapped inside her.
- 5. At about two boat lengths from the mark, Arch de Triomphe bore away to pass to leeward of White Pointer.
- 6. Hot Chipps bore away to avoid contact with Arch de Triomphe, passing close astern of Ragnar.
- 7. There was no contact

Conclusions:

- 1. Arch de Triomphe had established an inside overlap on Hot Chipps approximately 6 boat lengths from Mark 3 and remained overlapped at the zone.
- 2. Hot Chipps gave Arch de Triomphe mark room.


