

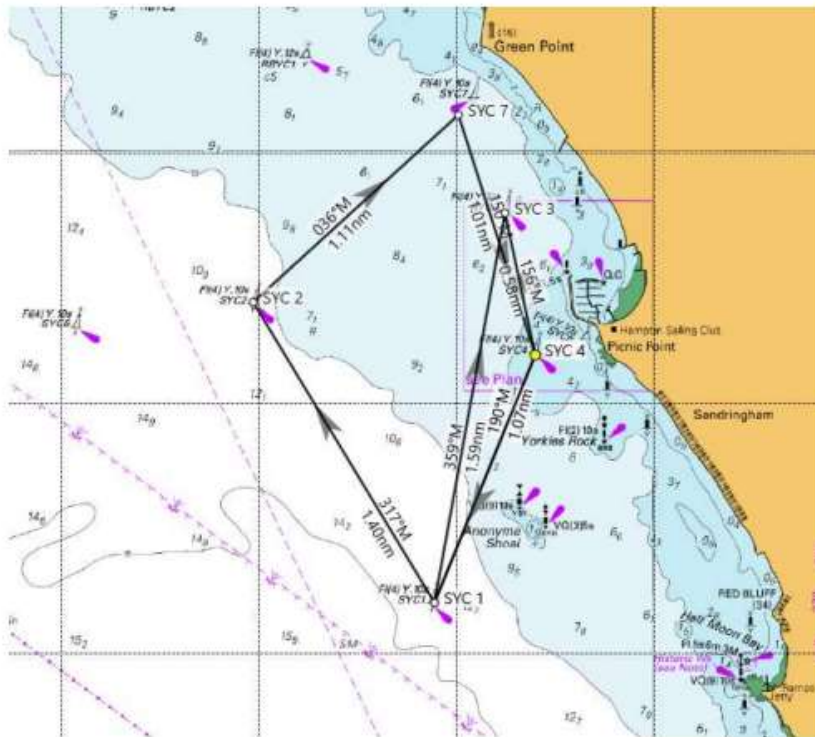
# Sunday Sailors Report – Race 6 (3 July 2022)

## The Winners

Congratulations to the winning boat Antares (Vandestadt) crewed by Grant Stewart and Darrin Pearce.

Antares is now 6<sup>th</sup> in the series having recorded a 10<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> and 1<sup>st</sup> in the races she has entered.

She started the season on a handicap of -2 which has not changed. Watch out for next race.

Just 13 seconds behind in second place was Amicus II (Swanson 30 - Warwick Stenford) off a handicap of 7. Amicus has had an 8<sup>th</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place putting her 3<sup>rd</sup> overall in the series. Amicus II started 51 seconds late, which arguably cost her first place.

Alegria (Catalina 309 - Simon May) won 3<sup>rd</sup> place on the podium finishing nearly 2 minutes behind Amicus II.

Alegria is still leading the series with Hitchhiker in second place and equal 3<sup>rd</sup> places being shared by Amicus II and Winsome.

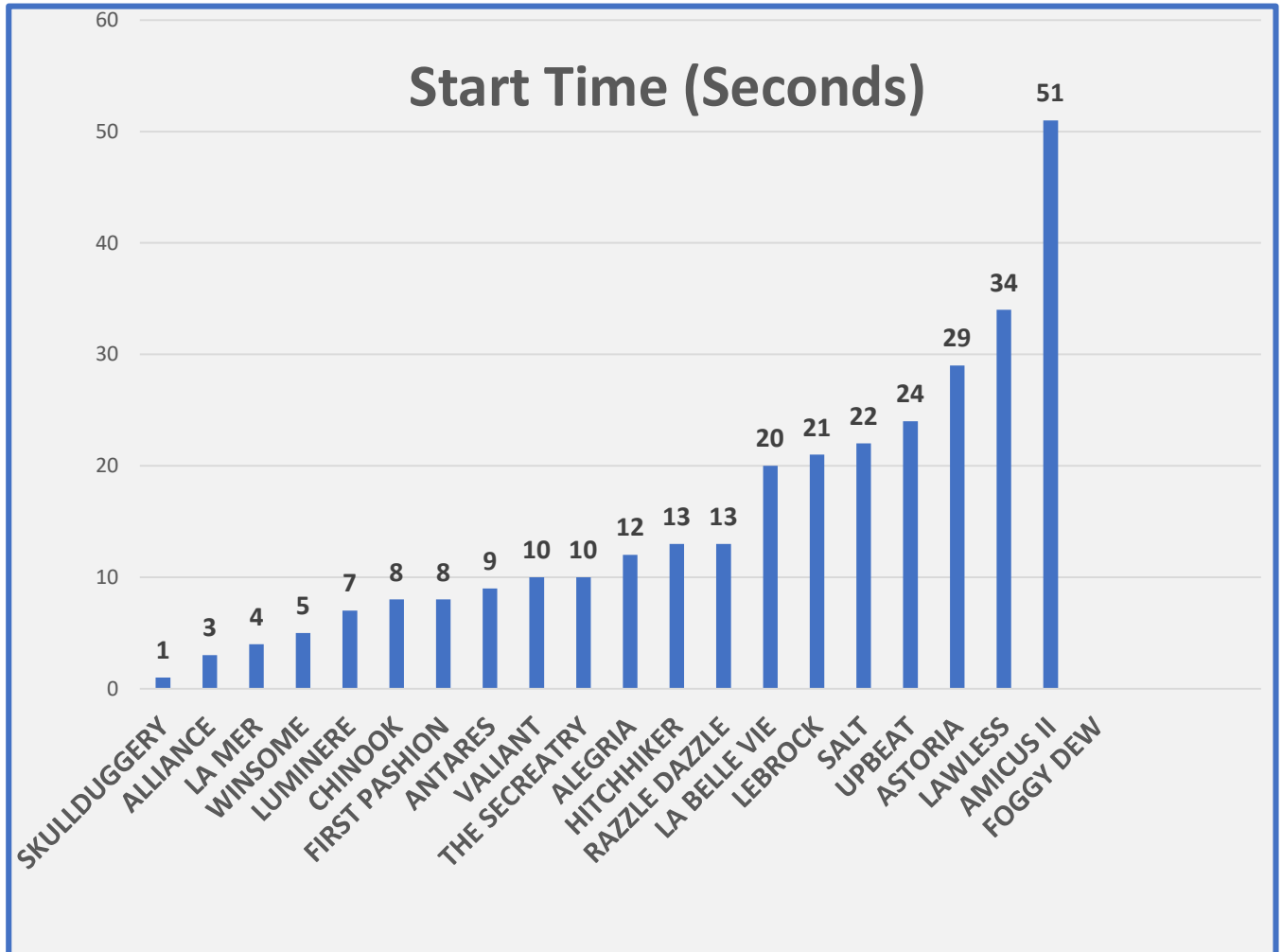


## The Start

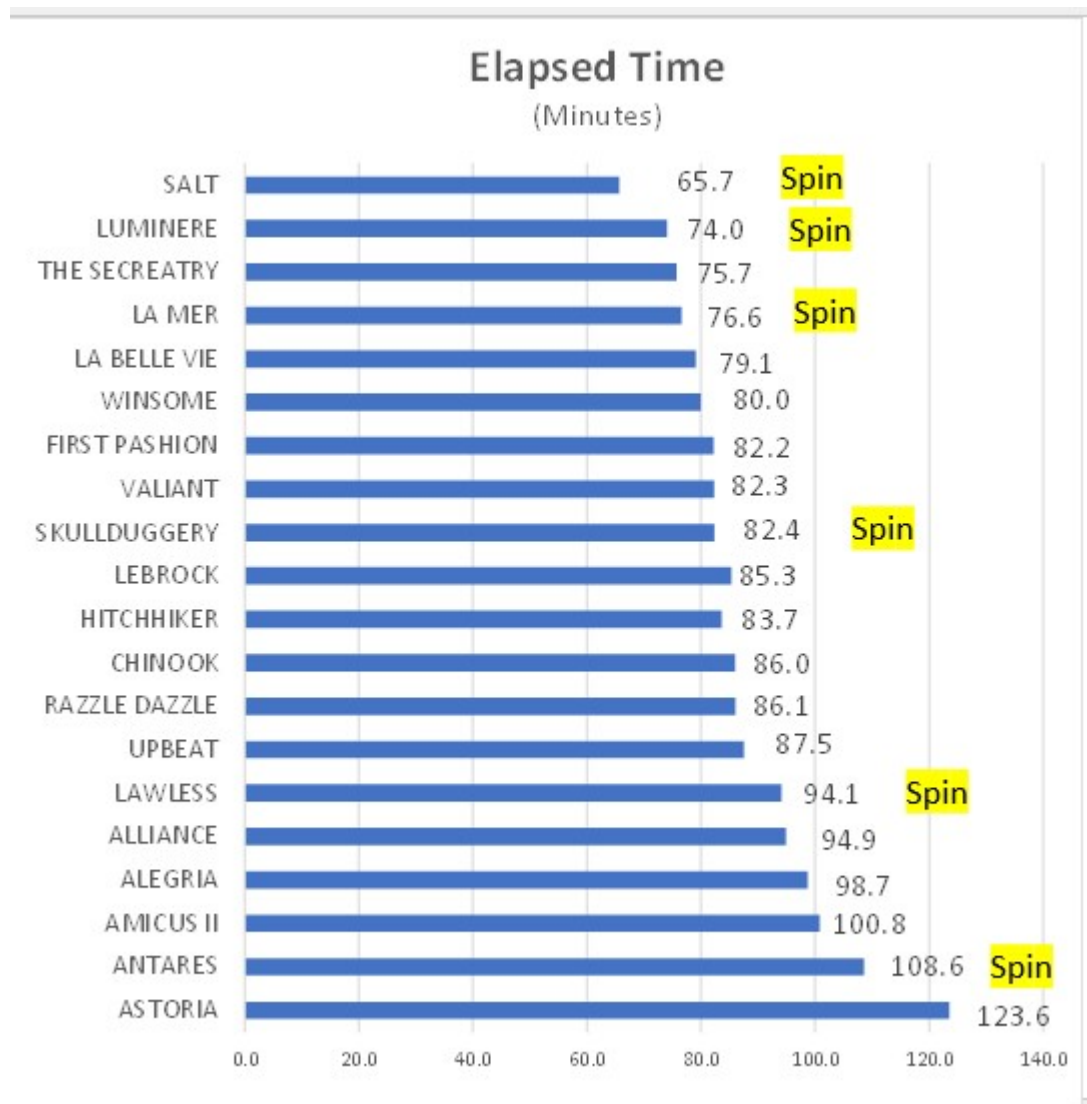
## Boat Speed

Two 50 footers were the fastest around the course.

Salt (Solaris 50– Ian Fankhanel) flying a spinnaker with a handicap of 56 scooped the best overall elapsed time by 8 minutes to the next fastest boat which was Luminere (Beneteau First 50 - Matt Kebbell). who also flew a spinnaker off a handicap of 53.

But size and Spinnakers aren't everything.

Just 1 minute in elapsed time behind Luminere was The Secretary (J44 – George Shaw) with no Spinnaker and off a handicap of 41. And another one minute was La Mer (Dufour 36 Performance – Michael Ebeling) off a handicap of 45 using a spinnaker.

## General Gossip and Handicap Monitoring

The standout 'tower try on' was Foggy Dew, hoping that no one would notice that they started around 9 minutes early.

But the ever-vigilant tower team spotted it. The result - a DNS for this race. Equal last.

It's not clear whether they decided to use the handicap that they thought they deserved, or got confused between Irish and Melbourne time zones, or just accidentally crossed early in pre-start manoeuvres.

What goes on water, stays on water (unless Leeward Larry finds out about it!).

The table below shows changes in base handicaps for the season to date.

Notable changes are:

LEBROCK: Installed new sails and now starting 4 minutes earlier (Heh - just looking at the numbers).

HOT CHIPPS: No doubt hoped the handicapper wouldn't notice the boat upgrade. 13-minute adjustment.

ALLEGRIA: Copped a 4-minute penalty after winning race 2. Then no change after coming second in Race 3. Now after coming 3<sup>rd</sup> in Race 6 we all wait with anticipation to see what the handicapper will do to them.

And a number of boats had some significant first race adjustments:

ASTORIA: Handicap reduced 6 minutes over 2 races.

CAFER RACER: After first race eased by 17 minutes to then win Race 3.

EMERALD: Moved from 40 up to 28 after the first race.

WATERLINE: Moved back from 33 to 50 after her first race.
