
SUNDAY SAILORS REPORT JANUARY 8 2023





Results

Three boats flew spinnakers and they finished 1st, 3rd and 6th. The long leg from 1 to 6 was ideal for a spinnaker set and they more than recouped their penalties. First was **Firefox (Kim Beveridge/Anthony Clyne)** who sailed very well. Second was **Lawless (Boyd Coulsen)** who held off the larger boats to gain second. Third was **First Passion (Simon Lipman)** who had the race won before they diverted off in the direction of Brighton on the third leg. They had a sheet caught in the spinnaker and couldn't get it down. They recovered well to finish third. **Upbeat (Peter Dunne)** and **Razzle Dazzle (Grahame Jones**) dead heated for fourth. Sixth was **Skullduggery (Garry MacCarten)** – the last of the spinnaker boats, just holding off the fast finishing **Winsome (Simon Hemingway)** who finished seventh.

Start of the Day

The standard of the starts in a near drifter was very good. Fleet average start was 17 seconds (second best recorded) with 40% of the boats starting within 10 seconds of their allocated time. Winners were **Winsome**, closely followed by **Valiant** (that old stager **David Keyes-Tilley**, or is it Tilley-Keyes, I get confused).

Firefox was the winner today. Also: First Passion on her way to third- overtaking Upbeat who finished equal 4^{th} .


Half Time Score

Only one lap so no half time score, no orange break or player substitutions.

Elapsed times



First Passion (under spinnaker) had the fastest time of 107 minutes, followed by **Winsome** and **Upbeat** (111 minutes and 112 minutes). 9 minutes covered the times from 2nd fastest to 8th fastest, so pretty even. The average elapsed time was 124 minutes. Over 5nm (the course was shortened) this was an average VMG of 2.4 knots – the slowest so far, in the lightest winds.






First (Firefox), 4th (Upbeat) and third (First Passion).

START AND FINISH POSITIONS

Firefox (5 places) and First Passion (9 places) were the big improvers. Winsome and Upbeat also gained 4 places. As the race was shortened this curtailed some place moves.



SERIES LEAD

The top three remain the same although **Skullduggery** has taken 2^{nd} off **Emerald (Tony Tanner**) – who finished 10^{th} today to The Skulls 6^{th} . **Valiant** remains in front (9^{th} today – which was dropped). The top 4 are separated by less than 5 points (**Razzle Dazzle** 4th). **La belle Vie**- last series winner is 5^{th} .

Gossip and other matters.


