
We currently have close to 70 sailors registered over the three fleets, so sailors should expect an exciting weekend of racing.

Change Rooms

Boat drop off

Boats can be dropped off from 4:30pm to 7:30pm on Friday 8 March. Drop off will be available from 7:30am on Saturday 9 March. Please enter the club at point 1 on the above map then turn right into the boat yard at point 4.

Car and trailer parking

- Throughout the regatta, we have Trey Bit Reserve available for car and trailer parking. Trey Bit Reserve is located halfway down Jetty Road (at the roundabout) and this parking is provided at no cost (see image below). Please do not park on the cricket pitch.
- Once boats are dropped off, all trailers must be moved to Trey Bit Reserve and are not to be stored in the SYC Yard.
- No cars are to be parked in the SYC yard as access is required at all times for emergency services and boat yard operations.



Boat Storage

- Boat storage will be at the Off the Beach grassed area (see point 14 on site map).

Regatta Office

- The Regatta Office is located in the Auditorium on the Ground Floor, entry via the northern end of the Clubhouse.
- Registration will be open on Saturday 9 March from 8am to 10am.

First Aid

- There will be first aid facilities onsite, please contact the Boating Office or Regatta Office for assistance. In the case of an emergency, please call 000 or 112.

Honorary Membership

 All non-SYC members are welcome to use the SYC Clubhouse over the weekend as honorary members. We ask that all patrons over the age of 18 years please register for a wristband at the Boating Office, SYC Reception or the Regatta Office – this helps us comply with liquor licensing requirements.

Food & Beverage

- **OTB Canteen**: The OTB canteen will be open all three days over the weekend. This will be run by volunteers from VIODA and will have a number of lunch, snack and drink options available.
- **Ken King Centre**: Snacks, wraps, coffee and bar service. Open 9:00am to 11:30am Saturday and 8:30am to 10:00am Sunday and is closed on the Monday.
- **Clubhouse**: Open from 11.30am Saturday & Sunday for Lunch. Dinner from 5.30pm. Note, the Clubhouse is closed on the Monday until 4pm.

Sign-on & Sign-off

- We are using TopYacht for sign-on. When sign-on is available a text message will be sent to the phone number registered to the sailor.

- Additionally, we will post QR codes around the boat park for your convenience. Please scan the QR code to mark yourself 'On Water' before you leave the shore. Scan again to mark yourself 'On Land' when you're back ashore.
